

48-Hour Visual Art Competition **Rules and Regulations**

It is required that you thoroughly read and agree to abide by the Rules and Regulations before registering for the Competition and submitting entries.

Submission Requirements

Entries: Up to 3

Medium: Any work done on canvas or paper

Valid file formats: .jpeg, .png

Maximum size: Image - no larger than 1024 x 1024 pixels; file - no larger than 4MB*

Minimum size: Image - no smaller than 500 x 500 pixels

Theme/Prompt: Will be sent in the “48-Hour Competition Start” email

*Images exceeding size requirements may fail to submit properly and/or will be resized and may be distorted

Competition Timeline

Registration Deadline: Wednesday July 28th at 11:59pm EST

Competition Start: Friday July 30th at 6pm EST

Competition End: Sunday August 1st at 6pm EST

All entries must be original artwork, created within the 48-hour Competition timeline, and must be submitted by the Competition end Date/Time.

Eligibility

Age Requirements

Entrants must be aged 16 years or older by the start date of the Competition for which they've registered.

Residency Requirements

Entrants must reside in the Niagara region.

Registration Fees

All purchases are FINAL. There is NO refund for entry fees.

Standard Rate: \$15.00 CAD

Student Rate: \$10.00 CAD*

*"Student Rate" is available to currently enrolled high school students. Eligible students must provide the grade level and name of the high school where they are enrolled.

If the entrant enters into multiple Competitions, each Competition fee must be paid separately.

Content Guidelines & Judging Criteria

All Judging Decisions Are Final

Appropriate Content

Submitted work by entrants must fit the Competition's criteria, including theme/prompt, and be appropriate for public use.

Entries in each Competition will go through an approval process to determine if the work meets all criteria before the entry will be made available for judging in its Competition.

Individual proprietors are entitled to reject the publication/distribution/display of work if they deem the work inappropriate for their audience.

Adherence To Criteria

The artwork must be an original piece created within the 48-Hour Competition event time frame.

Copyright Infringement

All work must be released for individual usage or purpose usage grants. All entries must contain copyright-free art or art released for entrant's and public use. Unauthorized use of copyrighted images, text, music or other materials is prohibited.

General Conditions

Online Submissions

All entries must be submitted using the online form sent to the entrant via the "48-Hour Competition Start" email.

Change or Adjustments to Prize(s)

Entrants will be notified if in any instance, a stated prize is no longer available or has to be cancelled due to extenuating circumstances. It will be replaced with a prize of equal or greater value.

Change or Adjustments to Judge(s)

Entrants will be notified if in any instance, a stated judge/guest judge is no longer able to take part due to extenuating circumstances. CREATE Niagara is committed to finding a replacement judge. If an alternate guest judge is not available, the CREATE Niagara team will select the winning submission.

Technical Difficulties/Support

CREATE Niagara, Vaylin Entertainment, all sponsors of events, and any employee or representative of those aforementioned organizations are not responsible for entries not received due to technical issues and accept no responsibility for technical or online support.

CREATE Niagara Reserves The Sole Right To Adjust Competitions Rules Without Notifying Entrants

Based on the volume of entries or legal requirements, Competition rules can be changed and updated without notice. Competition participants are responsible for checking the website for changes, and should review the Competition Rules prior to each submission.

Acceptance Notification

Every artist whose work is selected as the winning piece in each 48-Hour Competition will receive an email notification. All other 48-Hour Competition participants will receive an email notifying them of the results of that Competition.
